

INFORMATION CLAUSE

According to the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016, hereinafter referred to as GDPR, we would like to inform you that:

1. Your personal data controller is the University of Gdańsk with its seat in (80-309) Gdańsk at ul. Jana Bażyńskiego 8.
2. The controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO) who may be contacted by phone at (58) 523 24 59 or by e-mail at: poin@ug.edu.pl. You may contact DPO with regard to any issue related to your personal data processing and to the rights that are connected to the processing.
3. Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of organizing and conducting the „Modeling and Design of Molecular Materials 2020” conference.
4. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6 section 1 letter a of the General regulation on personal data protection as of 27th April 2016 - consent of the data subject.
5. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but any denial to do so may result in the refusal to be registered at the conference.
6. Your personal data will be processed on behalf of the controller by authorised personnel solely for the purposes referred to in section 3.
7. Your personal data will be stored for the consent period but no longer then till the end of 2020. In addition, the Administrator reserves the right to store personal data for the period necessary to determine, investigate or defend claims, but not beyond the expiry of the period of limitation.
8. Your personal data will be disclosed to the following third party: CONREGO Sp. z o.o. Sp. k., Plac Jana Pawła II 108a/2, 66-400 Gorzów Wlkp., Poland, company providing services IT for the event .
9. Under the terms of the GDPR you have the right to:
 - a) access your data,
 - b) rectify your data, should it be inaccurate,
 - c) erase your data, restrict the processing of it as well as the right to data portability – in cases laid down by law,
 - d) object to the processing of your data,
 - e) lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority – President of the Personal Data Protection Office, should you consider that the processing of your data infringes the personal data protection regulations.
 - f) withdrawing your consent at any time and that the withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on this consent prior to its withdrawal.
